The dutiful Police officers immediately tested the food and it contained ecstasy. Officers then approached drive-in fast-food restaurant employees to begin their investigation and arrested three Sonic Drive-In employees.

Further reports state that 30-year-old Tanisha Dancer, Sonic Manager was arrested and at the Williamson County Jail, she was found with three Ecstasy pills. She was then charged with the Possession of a Controlled Substance.

22-year-old Jose Molina, Sonic employee was arrested and charged with marijuana possession.

The investigations are still on and the Taylor Police Department is reviewing this case for any other pending charges.
